



# How to access a Quiz in a Moodle course on a mobile device

1. To access and complete a quiz in Moodle, navigate to the Quiz activity within the specific module. Note: Proctored exams administered via ProctorU or Examity cannot be accessed on a mobile device.



2. Click on the Quiz activity to display instructions for the quiz. Click the "Attempt quiz now" button to start the quiz.



- Depending on the quiz settings, the questions may appear all on one page or on separate pages. You may be able to navigate between the separate question pages, or you may only be able to view each question page in sequence.
- Select or enter your answers to each question, and navigate to the “Previous page” or “Next page,” if applicable. Note: your quiz questions types may vary: multiple choice, true false, short answer, or essay questions are most commonly used.






